Grass Cutting

 2. Ideally, grass will be cut three times a season: mid June, late July, early September
 3. Arrange to go with a buddy (see phone & email list)
 4. where crop leaves no room for walking, grass should be cut
 * two bear cats & two Stihl brush cutters; gas supplied
