

Trail Monitor. A Trail Monitor is assigned a section of the Avon Trail by the Trail Captain and ensures that it is safe for walkers and that the trail is easy to follow. Monitors work in pairs and walk their sections a minimum of twice in spring and once in autumn (many visit their sections more often). Duties include light grooming along the path using pruners and loppers, refreshing the trail navigation "blazes" (see ['How to make Your Own Blaze Kit'](#)) and reporting to the club of any hazards or obstacles. Once a section is assigned to a Monitor she or he is fully trained on site by the Trail Captain. Join us and take part in the workings of this wonderful walking trail.
