

Trail Reroute for Map 04, Edition 7.0 (2016 MAY 01)



Explanation

Thanks to generous land owners, this reroute removes *about* 1.0 km of the trail from roads compared to Map 04 in Edition 6.0 and Edition 7.0 (current edition). The change in distance for this reroute is a reduction of *about* 300 m (0.3km). The change in distance is rather insignificant but is depicted on the reroute map on page two.

Revised Trail Description for Map 04, Edition 7.0

km 68.0 – Wilmot Easthope Rd. (43.435353, -80.763959)

The trail jogs right (SE) for about 10 m along Wilmot Easthope Rd, then turns left into a mature woodlot on the south side of a drain (ditch) flowing NE. The trail continues into an open grassy area of a residential home, crosses a laneway into a cropped field. **Note: Do not walk along the laneway.** Crossing the laneway, the trail turns left (north) along the edge of the field for about 100 m to the drain, turns right (NE) to follow the drain about 100 m to a plank bridge crossing the drain. Across the creek (drain), the trail turns right and continues 100 m to the corner of the field where it turns left (NW) for about 300 m along the property line between two cropped fields, ***staying on the west of the property line***. The trail exits the field turning right (NE) along Carmel-Koch Rd for about 200 m to Krampien Drain (a small creek) at km 69.1.

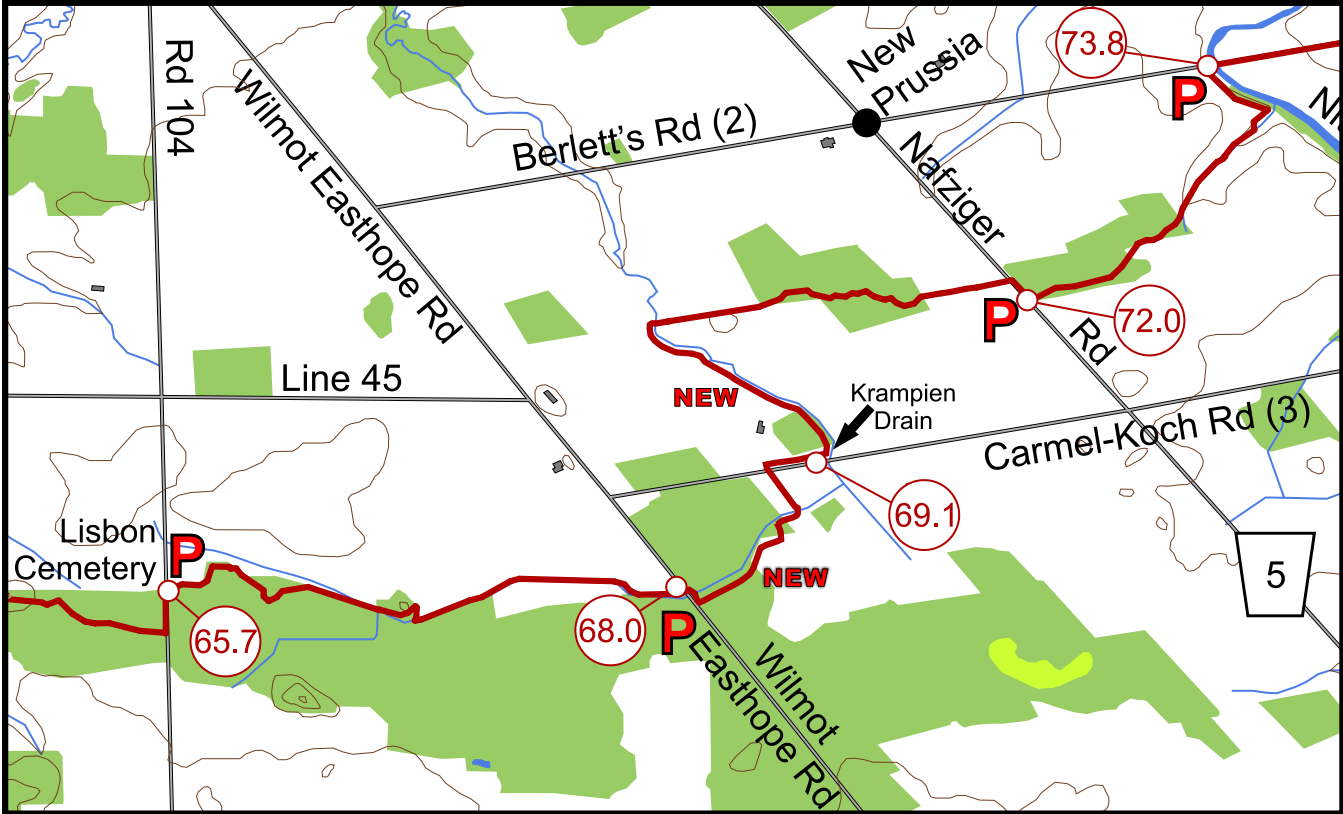
km 69.1 – Carmel-Koch Rd. (43.440478, -80.757252)

Before crossing the creek, the trail turns left (NW) and follows the edge of the field on the west side of the drain for about 50 m, before entering woodlot about 350 m in extent, then emerges into a field. It continues on the west side of the field and another small copse of about 50 m. Emerging from there, it continues to follow the drain along the edge of the field for about 100 m and turns right and across the drain on wooden bridge. From there, the trail proceeds east (NE) along the south side of the tree line till it enters another hardwood forest. It proceeds through there for about 500 m before entering a field. It follows along the left side of the fence till it reaches a home property fence. It proceeds through there and continues on the left side of the coniferous trees along the fence, until reaching Nafziger Rd.
